#### MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

On this Second Sunday of Advent, I want to share some thoughts that I spoke about in my homily during the Vigil Mass on the First Sunday of Advent last Saturday. Since many of you were probably celebrating the Buckeyes' victory over Michigan, I will present a condensed version of my sermon because I believe you may find it helpful for your spiritual life as you pray your way through the season of Advent.

"Mindfulness" is a word that we use to describe the grace of living in the present moment and not being distracted by regrets from the past or worries about the future. In my sermon, I described my resolve to pay attention and remain focused on the present moment as I was celebrating Mass, and not letting myself be distracted by wandering thoughts.

I think that all of us should seek this mindfulness. Let us be mindful of the present moment. Let us give our full attention to it. Let's not let our minds race ahead and worry and fret about the future, so that we don't pay attention to the here and now.

The season of Advent is a season of preparation and anticipation. It is a time of patient waiting for the fulfillment of God's promise. Advent calls us to be prepared for a future event, whether that be the "coming of the Son of Man," or the feast of Christmas. But our preparations for the future should not distract us from the present moment.

I want to suggest that during this season of Advent, we seek mindfulness each and every day of Advent. Don't dwell on the past – it only leads to regret or sadness. Don't dwell on the future – it leads to anxiety and worry. Rather, let us be mindful, and focus our attention on the present moment, because that is where we find God.






