I also hope and pray that you will experience good health and happiness in the new year.

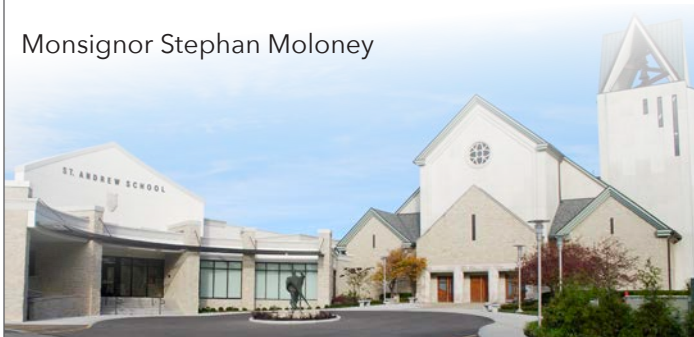
I want to thank you for your expressions of sympathy and prayers on the occasion of the death of my sister, Mary Jane Moloney, who died on December 26. I celebrated her funeral Mass on Friday, Jan. 2, at Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Ada, Ohio. My sister had some health problems recently, but we did not expect to lose her. 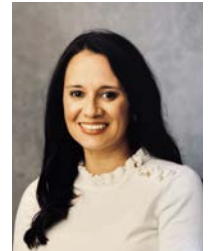



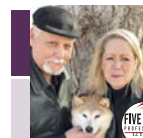
