## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This week, we observe a solemn and sad anniversary: Thursday, January 22, marks the 63rd anniversary of the 1973 Supreme Court decision "Roe v. Wade," which made abortion legal throughout the United States. Although the U.S. Supreme Court overturned that decision in 2022, there is no guaranteed legal protection for the lives of the unborn. For this reason, the Catholic Church in the U.S. observes a day of prayer and penance on January 22 – prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life, and penance for the violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.

Our parish Respect Life committee has also taken steps to remind us of the continuing importance of this issue, including the cross display in the churchyard and the "40 Days for Life" promotion. Obviously, it is still of great importance and urgency for us to advocate for the protection of the unborn. At the same time, we must advocate for the protection of all life, "from conception to natural death." Respect Life means ALL life. God commanded us: "Thou shalt not kill." It is an all encompassing commandment. I have been disturbed lately by the frequent news reports of murders, deadly violence, mass shootings, bombings, and just plain killings, whether legal or illegal. The first murder was when Cain slew his brother Abel. Things have only gotten worse since then.

As we pray for the protection of the unborn and do penance for those lives snuffed out by abortion, we must also pray that all human lives be protected from harm and that those who would dare to inflict harm on others would be thwarted. We must also do penance for all of the violations of the dignity of the human person committed through acts of killing. We must advocate for those who have been deprived of life by acts inflicted by others. That is what it means to "respect life."

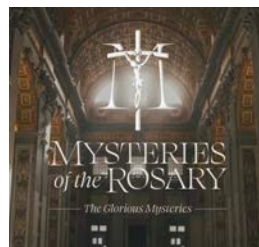

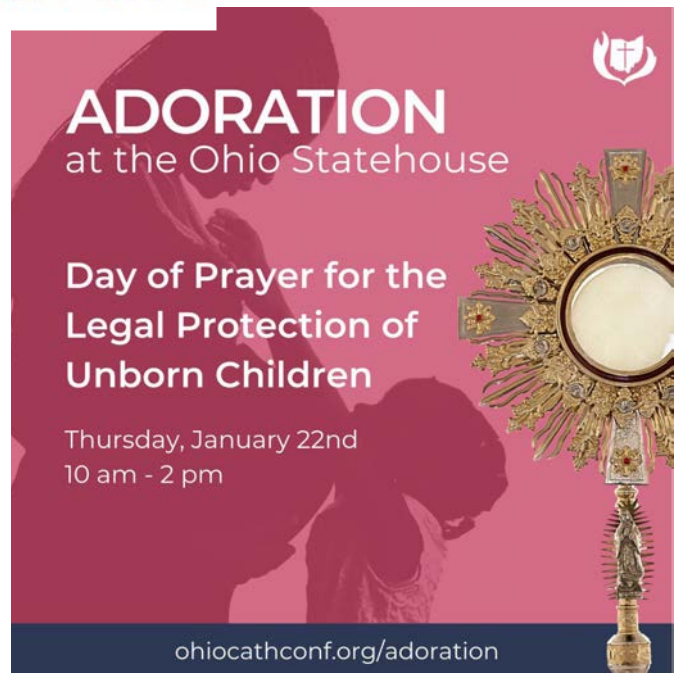

## DAY OF PRAYER AND PENANCE ADORATION AT THE OHIO STATEHOUSE


THURSDAY, JANUARY 22 // 10:00 AM-2:00 PM

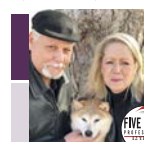
