The Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord

The Epiphany marks the arrival of visitors, identified in Scripture as the Magi, to the place where Jesus was born. Although we know virtually nothing about them, we do know they brought three gifts:

1. **Gold** – a symbol of wealth and power, identifies the recipient as a king.
2. **Frankincense** – the crystallized resinous sap of a tree used as incense and as an offering, is symbolic of prayer.
3. **Myrrh** – another resinous tree sap, was used in healing liniments and as an embalming ointment. Myrrh is an odd gift for a child, so even at the beginning of Jesus' life on earth, this gift foreshadows His death.

For much of the secular world, the holiday season has died down. Reflect on the joys of the holiday season and what you have left to celebrate when the decorations are put away.



EUCARISTIC ADORATION

Please join us for Eucharistic Adoration on Tuesdays from 6:00-9:00 p.m. Eucharistic Adoration is simply the act of being in Christ's real presence while the Eucharist is on the altar. Adorers may stay as briefly or as long as they would like. Adoration concludes at 8:45 p.m. with Compline (end of day prayers) and Benediction. Make time to be in Christ's presence and open yourself to the graces that flow from the Eucharist!

Weekly Adoration Hosts: Parish Council (first Tuesday); St. Vincent de Paul (second Tuesday); Walking With Purpose (third Tuesday); Men of the Parish (fourth Tuesday).

THE HEARING LOOP SYSTEM IS AVAILABLE DURING MASS

For those who experience hearing loss and use hearing aids, St. Andrew Parish offers the telecoil, or T-coil, hearing loop system in the church. The T-coil hearing loop system reduces most background noise and improves understanding of speech and music.

If you would like to take advantage of the T-coil function in the church, you will need to ask your Hearing Care Provider (HCP) to add it to your device. After this, simply press the button on the back of your hearing aid and select the program that your HCP has assigned to T-coil.

WOULD YOU LIKE TO SCHEDULE A HOME VISIT WITH A PRIEST? If you or a family member are sick, homebound or hospitalized and would like a visit from a priest, please call the parish office at 614-451-4290 and speak with Msgr. Moloney, ext. 101, or Fr. Tabi, ext. 103. Visits may include Reconciliation, Holy Communion, and anointing.

IN AN EMERGENCY: If someone is near death, call the parish office at 614-451-4290 and press 3 (Sacramental Emergency Line). A priest will respond as quickly as possible. If the call comes after business hours or on the weekend, please allow extra time as the priests may be attending to other sacramental needs.

3. Sign the CODE OF CONDUCT.
4. Complete a VOLUNTEER APPLICATION.

OCT. 17TH – 20TH SORRENTO:

We will spend 3 nights at our Mountain & Seaside Resort, The Hotel Gran Paradiso (4 Stars) overlooking the Bay of Naples & Mount Vesuvius. Included is daily breakfast and 4 course dinner every evening with the twinkling lights from the City of Naples below us.

Oct. 17th ~ Our first day after check in, rest by the poolside or head down into Sorrento to do some exploring, depending on how you feel. Dinner on the hotel terrace.

Oct. 18th ~ Day Trip: We will be visiting the costal town of Amalfi and the Basilica of St. Andrea & Mass at the Apostle's tomb. After lunch in Positano and an afternoon exploring, we will return to Sorrento by ferry. Dinner on the hotel terrace.

Oct. 19th ~ Day Trip: After Breakfast we will be taking the express ferry from the port of Sorrento to the Isle of Capri. Transfer up to the mountaintop town of Anna Capri. This quaint village offers shops, cafes, and a chair lift to the top of Mount Solar with its beautiful view of the Tyrrhenian Sea. Dinner at the hotel terrace.

OCT. 20TH – 26TH VATICAN CITY, ASSISI, & ROME:

Oct. 20th ~ We Transfer via Luxury Motor Coach to our apartments in the famous Borgo Neighborhood adjacent to Vatican City, at the Trianon Borgo Pio. We are 5 minutes from St. Peter's Square. Breakfast will be daily on the Apartments Roof Top Terrace, overlooking St. Peter's Square & the Basilica. After check in we will be explore the Old Historic City Center with its famous monuments & churches. Dinner on your own on the famous Borgo Pio!!!

Oct. 21st ~ After early breakfast we head over to pass through security into St. Peter's Square for the Wednesday Papal Audience with The Holy Father. After lunch on the Borgo we will head out for visits to the following sites: St. John Lateran, the Holy Stairs & finishing up our day with Mass at the Basilica of Mary Major along with viewing Pope Francis' Tomb. Return to our neighborhood and dinner on your own.

Oct. 22nd ~ Very early departure for St. Peter's Basilica for our private Mass & visit. After our visit we will make our way back to our apartments for breakfast before heading to the Vatican Museum & Sistine Chapel. Remainder of your day exploring the Borgo neighborhood or climbing up to the Cupola of St. Peter's Basilica. Dinner on your own.

Oct. 23rd ~ Day trip to the mountainside town of Assisi and Mass at St. Francis' Tomb. Remainder of the day will include visits to tombs of St. Carlo Acutis & St. Clare. Time for Lunch and exploring. Before heading back to Rome we visit the Portiuncula (church in a church). Dinner on your own.

Oct. 24th ~ Mass at the Basilica of St. Andrea (Andrew) della Valle, (church that St. Maximilian Kolbe was ordained in). Late morning visit to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. Lunch across from the Famous Roman Coliseum. Mid afternoon visit to the Coliseum. Return to our neighborhood and dinner on your own.

Oct. 25th ~ Sunday morning Mass at Santo Spirito (the American Mass in Rome) or at the Altar of the Chair in St. Peter's Basilica. (Your option) Noon blessing by Pope Leo and remainder of your day on your own. Dinner as a group or on your own. To be determined.

Oct. 26th ~ Motor Coach transfer from our apartments to Rome International Airport (FCO) for return to USA.
