

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I hope you have survived the historic winter storm that inundated us with snow, ice, and frigid temperatures beginning last Sunday.

Last weekend, the 4:30 p.m. Vigil Mass on Saturday was standing room only! That was before the snow began. By early Sunday morning, there was already about four inches of snow when I went over to the church at 7:00 a.m. Fr. Lawrence celebrated the 7:30 a.m. Mass with two people in attendance. I celebrated the 9:15 a.m. Mass and there were about 35 people present, mostly those living close by who walked to church, and at the 11:00 a.m. Mass, there were maybe 45 people who attended. I did have altar servers and lectors for 9:15 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses. Honestly, I did not expect to see so many people at these Masses. Those who attended were grateful that Mass was celebrated and they could attend, and nobody complained that there was no music and that the sidewalks were covered with snow!

The temperatures are still frigid and I want to remind everyone to use prudence when deciding whether or not to venture out in bad weather in order to come to church. Please heed all warnings and advisories, and if a Level 3 snow emergency is declared, you are not permitted to drive on the roads or streets. You are automatically dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. In other circumstances, you must make a judgment, but if you are concerned about the weather conditions and believe that traveling to church is unwise or risky, you should consider yourself legitimately excused from the obligation to attend Mass. Please remember this throughout the winter season. I would hate to have anyone, especially the elderly, to have an accident, get stuck in snow, or fall on the sidewalk because they tried to come to church when they should have stayed home.

Stay safe and warm during these extremely cold days, and may God bless you and protect you!

EUCARISTIC ADORATION

Please join us for Eucharistic Adoration on Tuesdays from 6:00-9:00 p.m. Eucharistic Adoration is simply the act of being in Christ's real presence while the Eucharist is on the altar. Adorers may stay as briefly or as long as they would like. Adoration concludes at 8:45 p.m. with Compline (end of day prayers) and Benediction. Make time to be in Christ's presence and open yourself to the graces that flow from the Eucharist!

PHASE 1 OF THE PARISH DATA CONVERSION BEGINS THIS MONTH!

During the first week of February, we will begin transitioning our giving tools at St. Andrew Parish to a new, more efficient resource: Pushpay. This is just the beginning of the larger transition to update and transfer all parishioner records. To ensure a successful parish-wide transition of the giving tool, we need your help moving your gifts to Pushpay. Our goal is to complete the giving part of the process by March 30, 2026. After that time, OSV Online Giving will no longer be available to parishioners.

IF YOU CURRENTLY MAKE A RECURRING GIFT THROUGH ONLINE GIVING, LOOK FOR AN EMAIL ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 10*: If you have an OSV Online Giving account and make recurring gifts, you will receive an email from Pushpay prompting you to make the switch. There are a few steps involved in the setup process that will be detailed in the email. The email will also include instructions on how to suspend your OSV Online Giving account.

**We have delayed the launch by one week. The parish office staff members want to be as fluent in the new system as possible to address your questions.*

IF YOU CURRENTLY USE ENVELOPES AND WOULD LIKE TO START GIVING ONLINE THROUGH PUSHPAY, this is a great opportunity to take the plunge. All giving links on the website, in ePOST, and in the bulletin now redirect you to Pushpay. It's quick, convenient, and most importantly, very secure!

PHASE 2 OF THE PARISH DATA CONVERSION WILL BEGIN AFTER WE UPDATE ALL PARISHIONER RECORDS!

You read that right! To complete phase 2 of the data migration, we must begin with updated records for every parish household.

The last time we did a database update was in 2019, just before the pandemic. Since that time, we migrated to a different diocesan data resource and some of the information before 2019 didn't transfer correctly. In the meantime, we tried to make as many updates as possible, but we know there's information that's still incorrect for many of you.

As a result, we're going back to the drawing board and asking a member of every parish household to complete a new registration form. You'll find the new form at the end of this bulletin. Please take a few minutes to complete the form for your family (only one per family, please).



SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

NATIVITY OF MARY SCHOLARSHIP is a multi-year \$2,000 scholarship to any rising ninth grade student who is attending a Catholic high school in the 2026-2027 school year. Awards from the Nativity of Mary Scholarship are \$2,000 per year. Provided that the student remains in good standing and continues to attend a Catholic high school in the Diocese of Columbus, the scholarship will be renewed each year until that student graduates. To apply, visit <https://catholic-foundation.org/grants/scholarships/the-nativity-of-mary-scholarship/>. **»The deadline to apply is February 27.**

THE HANDS AND FEET OF CHRIST SCHOLARSHIP awards \$800 to a student (rising eighth grade through rising high school senior) who plans to attend or is currently attending a Catholic high school during the 2026-2027 school year. Applicants will need to show a financial need via FACTS tuition assistance information and provide a letter of recommendation from a community leader (clergy, youth minister, teacher, etc.) confirming active involvement in the applicant's Catholic faith formation. This is a single-year scholarship. To apply, visit <https://catholic-foundation.org/grants/scholarships/the-hands-and-feet-of-christ-scholarship/>. **»The deadline to apply is February 27.**

FLORENCE MOSES NURSING SCHOLARSHIP is a one-time \$1,000 award to a Diocese of Columbus Catholic high school senior who has been accepted to and enrolled in the Mount Carmel College of Nursing. To apply, visit <https://catholic-foundation.org/grants/scholarships/florence-e-moses-nursing-scholarship/>. **»The deadline to apply is February 27.**

RONALD C. SULLIVAN SCHOLARSHIP awards \$100,000 (\$25,000 per year) to graduating high school seniors who will be incoming freshman at The Ohio State University. Ronald C. Sullivan was a man of faith, education, business, and duty. He considered his Catholicism the foundation of his identity and as a lifelong Buckeye of The Ohio State University, Sullivan saw a college education as a key to success.

Scholarship requirements: A current high school senior enrolled or about to enroll at The Ohio State University, a practicing Catholic (as verified by a letter from a parish leader such as a priest, deacon, or youth minister), active member of St. Andrew, St. Agatha, Our Lady of Victory, or St. Christopher, and solid academic performance.
