MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

The season of Lent is now underway. "The annual observance of Lent is the special season for the ascent to the holy mountain of Easter." I read those words recently, and it struck me what a good analogy this is! The penance and discipline of Lent is much like a difficult climb up a mountain, a slow and arduous uphill journey, which includes some obstacles and setbacks along the way. But, if we don't give up, we will be rewarded when we reach the summit! Let us together ascend God's holy mountain during this season of Lent, so that we may renew our baptismal promises at Easter.

Lent is also a season of renewal. Last Sunday, during the offerings at Mass, the words "cleanse and renew" were used ("May this oblation, O Lord we pray, cleanse and renew us..."). It is my hope and prayer that each one of us may be cleansed and renewed by our penance during this season of Lent. Let us be cleansed of our guilt and our sins, cleansed of the evil that still clings to us. Let us be renewed in our faith, in our zeal, in our enthusiasm to follow Christ with our whole heart, mind, and soul. May our vision be cleansed so that it is no longer jaded by envy or suspicion, or corrupted by lust, exaggerated by pride, or magnified by greed. May we be renewed and once again become like little children in our simplicity that we may enter the Kingdom of God. Let us open our hearts to the grace of Christ and His gifts of mercy, forgiveness, and reconciliation that flow through the sacraments, and let Him cleanse and renew us!

Please pray for our catechumens who will be called to the Easter Sacraments in the Rite of Election, which will take place today (Sunday, February 22) at St. Catharine Church. They will then continue their purification as they prepare to be baptized at the Easter Vigil. May all of us climb that mountain of Easter together, and support and help one another along the way.

If you have set up a recurring gift through OSV, and you did not receive the email, please contact the parish office. **Another email will be sent on Tuesday, February 24, to all recurring donors who have not made the update.** The email details how to set up a new account in Pushpay, and how to cancel your OSV account to avoid duplicate transactions.


