

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Lent, also known as "Laetare Sunday." This marks the midpoint of the penitential season of Lent, and represents a milestone in this season. "Laetare" means "Rejoice," and we are encouraged to rejoice because the season of penance and self-denial is halfway done. We are permitted a brief "holiday" from our penance before we begin "phase 2," that is, the second half of Lent. We shouldn't think of Laetare Sunday as a "hump" that we go over at the halfway point of Lent, and then we coast downhill to Easter. By no means! It is more like a brief pit stop to refuel your car and refresh yourself during a long road trip. There is still a long way to go!

On this Laetare Sunday, let us rejoice, but let us also prepare to complete our journey of Lent, this journey of 40 days of prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Back on Ash Wednesday, as we began this season of Lent, the opening prayer of Mass referred to our beginning "this campaign of Christian service" with "holy fasting," so that "as we take up battle against spiritual evils, we may be armed with the weapons of self-restraint."

So, after our brief pause to rejoice and regroup, let us continue this campaign, and take up those weapons of self-restraint once again.

Dear St. Andrew Parishioners:

Thank you for making the 2025 Festival at St. Andrew a success! We earned more than \$95,000 for the parish. Whether you donated a cake, were a sponsor, purchased a raffle ticket, or volunteered your time, you were a part of the success.

Our festival has become the event to attend at the end of summer. I have been a part of the planning committee since the first festival in 2001. Not only does the festival provide extra money for the parish, but I especially love how this event brings the community together both within and outside the parish. The festival celebrates the best of St. Andrew.

However, the future of the festival is uncertain. Volunteers of all kinds are the lifeblood of the festival. Last year it was very apparent there were just too few people doing the work of many. Filling 2.5 hour shifts during the festival gets harder every year.

For the planning committee, this is not a two-day event. Putting on the festival takes a lot of time and dedication. The festival has about 20 committees. In many cases the committees have one chair person and, in some cases, one person runs multiple committees. This is not sustainable. Many of our committee chairs have been acting in their roles for five years or more, and some for more than 20 years! Several committee chairs are unable to return for 2026. While we are always sad to see our loyal committee chairs move out of their positions, we welcome fresh ideas and energy!

That said, the festival committee NEEDS YOU! We are looking for parishioners to join the planning committee and/or become a committee chair for the 2026 festival. Please consider where you might fit in. We will be sharing more info about the committees in the coming weeks. Most current committee chairs are willing to help train new chairs. Without more people stepping up into those leadership roles, we will not be able to continue the festival at the level it is now.


