## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Today we observe Palm Sunday, the beginning of Holy Week. There are two Gospel readings at Mass today. We open Mass with the Gospel account of Jesus' triumphal entrance into Jerusalem, when the people greeted Him with cries of "Hosanna" and waved palm branches (Matthew 21:1-11). The next Gospel reading is the lengthy account of Jesus' Passion (The Passion according to St. Matthew). Because we bless and distribute palm branches today, we call this day "Palm Sunday." But it is also known as "Passion Sunday" because the Gospel of the Passion is read.

Because the Passion account is rather dramatic by its very nature, it is customary to proclaim the Passion in dialogue, with separate parts for the evangelist or "narrator," Jesus, "the voice," and "the crowd." The congregation takes the part of the crowd, and the priest takes the part of Jesus.

Every Mass is a memorial of the Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ, and we are reminded of this in the Eucharistic Prayers of the Mass. Eucharistic Prayer II reminds us that, at the time He was betrayed, Jesus "entered willingly into His Passion." The word "passion" is derived from the Latin verb "patior," which means to suffer. The past participle of patior is "passus." From these words are derived our words "patient," "patience," "passive," and "passion." But all of these words indicate the acceptance and endurance of suffering.

As we enter into the Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ during this Holy Week, let us learn to imitate His great patience whenever we experience the inevitable suffering of life, and willingly endure and accept them for His sake.

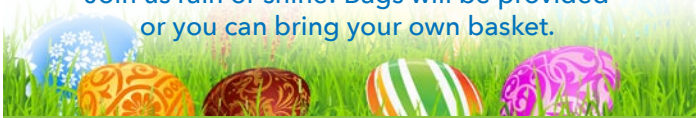

## »THE HEARING LOOP SYSTEM IS AVAILABLE DURING MASS:

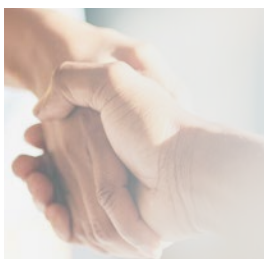
For those who experience hearing loss and use hearing aids, St. Andrew Parish offers the telecoil, or T-coil, hearing loop system in the church. The T-coil hearing loop system reduces most background noise and improves understanding of speech and music. **If you would like to take advantage of the T-coil function in the church,** you will need to ask your Hearing Care Provider (HCP) to add it to your device. After this, simply press the button on the back of your hearing aid and select the program that your HCP has assigned to T-coil.

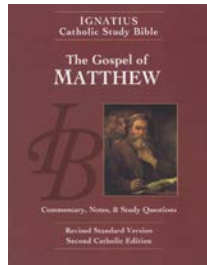

## REFLECT

The ability to cooperate with God's creative power to conceive and raise a child is one of the most profound gifts that a married couple can receive. Yet sadly, about 1 in 6 people face infertility at some point. For some, the joy of conception never happens. Others suffer repeated miscarriages. Still others experience secondary infertility: after giving birth to one or more children, they experience difficulty having another. When couples are unable to bear children, very often there is an understandable feeling of great loss. It is essential to note that the Church has true compassion for couples suffering from infertility and wants to be of real help to them. Many causes of infertility can be addressed through medical assistance that is fully in accord with Catholic teaching.

The desire to have a child is beautiful and good. At the same time, we are called to cooperate with God's design for married love and the creation of new life. Some practices, such as *in vitro* fertilization (IVF) and surrogacy, are not morally legitimate ways to address infertility. In addition to failing to respect the dignity of the couple's marital relationship and of the child, such procedures often result in the loss of human life.

St. John Paul II affirmed to couples who bear the Cross of infertility, "you are no less loved by God; your love for each other is complete and fruitful when it is open to others." It is important that couples who experience infertility know that their love is still *fruitful* and their married life remains filled with meaning. We pray that couples struggling with infertility would know Christ's closeness in a special way and embrace God's design as they seek to grow their families.

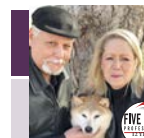
