

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Third Sunday of Lent. Two weeks ago, I spoke about the season of Lent as "a special season for the ascent of the Holy Mountain of Easter." So now that we are more than two weeks into the season, I must ask, how is that ascent going for you? How far have you climbed up that mountain? How much progress have you made?

It is a steep and challenging way to go up this mountain and arrive at the summit of Easter. The way is one of penance, prayer and self denial. We make our way, inch by inch, step by step, but we must keep at it all through the 40 days of Lent, or we won't make it to our goal.

Are you keeping your Lenten resolutions? Are you abstaining from meat on Fridays? Are you eating less, praying more? Are you talking less, laughing less, complaining less, cursing less? Are you thanking more, praising more, respecting more, helping more, serving more, giving more? If you answered "no" to any of these, well then it's time to get a move on!

Keep in mind that the week after next (March 16-20) is spring break. And while the break is a welcome period of leisure and relaxation for many, especially school students and families, it is still Lent. Spring break is not a vacation from Lent, and if we treat it as such, we will fall further behind in the ascent of the Holy Mountain of Easter!

Let us together climb God's Holy Mountain, and support and help each other along the way.
