Dear Parishioners,

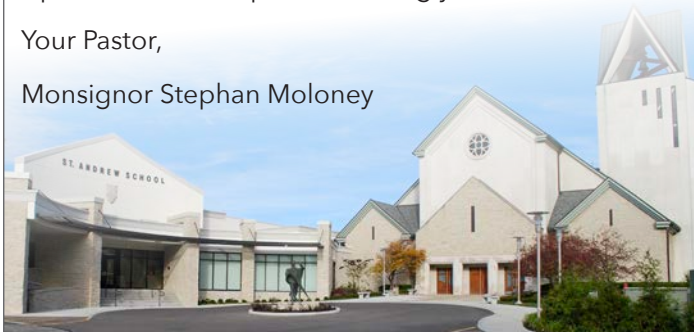

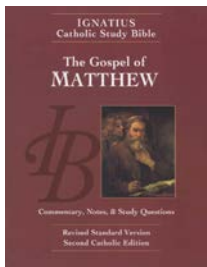

If you would like to schedule more than six Masses for one person, please consider supporting a different diocesan parish in need of Mass intentions.
