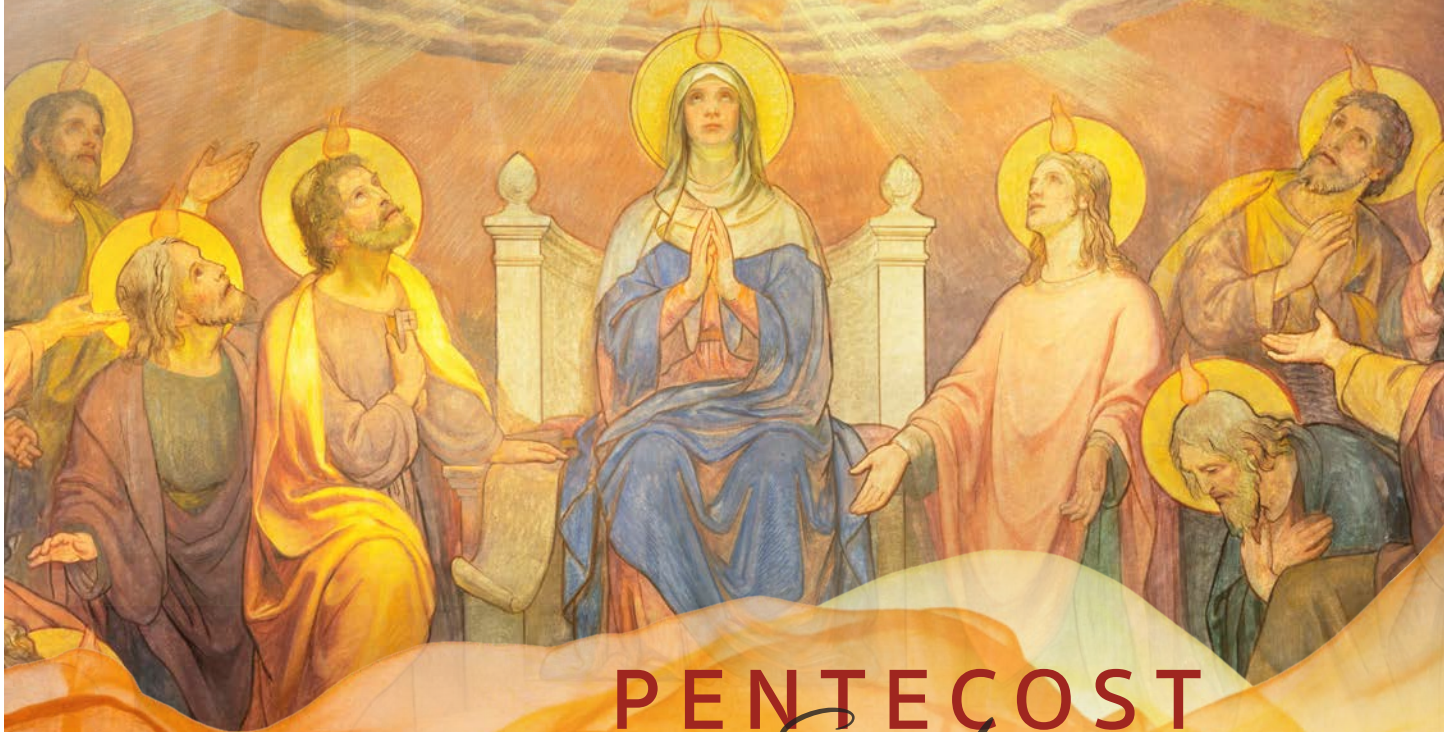

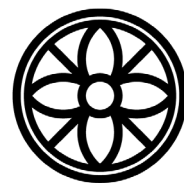

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Today, we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, which recalls the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, who appeared as tongues of fire, and emboldened them to go forth and proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all.

When the Spirit came upon the apostles who were huddled together in fear, it made a great noise, "like a strong, driving wind," (Acts 2:2) This makes me ask a question: Does the Holy Spirit always make such a loud and noisy entrance when He comes? The answer is NO! In fact, the Holy Spirit more often than not comes quietly, subtly, almost imperceptively. But as quietly and gently as the Spirit moves and acts, the Spirit accomplishes a powerful transformation.

In the ordinations of a priest, the Bishop lays his hands on the head of the one being ordained, indicating the gift of the Holy Spirit. During the Eucharistic Prayer of the Mass, the priest extends his hands over the bread and chalice filled with wine and invokes the Spirit to come upon them (this moment is called the "epiclesis") and makes them holy. This Spirit comes gently and mysteriously "like the snowfall." There are examples of how the gentle, hidden, and silent activity of the Holy Spirit can transform reality and make God truly present and His Word effective and life-giving. May the Holy Spirit be at work in you, and make you the witnesses and messengers of the Gospel of Christ!

I am hoping and praying that the Holy Spirit will inspire many more of you to make a generous gift to The Appeal 2026. As of May 15, we have \$63,721 pledged toward our goal of \$229,705. I am grateful to those who have pledged. It seems though that we are off to a slow start, and we are still a long way from our goal. I have been emphasizing two things about this year's appeal: First, we should support The Appeal because it is the right thing to do, especially our sharing in the diocese's mission of evangelization. Second, I hope to increase parishioner participation in The Appeal beyond last year's 14% level. So if you have not yet made a pledge or gift to The Appeal, and especially if you have never previously participated, please give! Make a pledge or gift today! The Holy Spirit is moving me to gently urge you to do this. May the same Spirit move your heart to respond.

This week marks the end of the school year for St. Andrew School and graduation is on May 28. Congratulations to the St. Andrew Class of 2026, and to all graduates. Also, congratulations to Rev. Zachary Goodchild, who was ordained to the holy Priesthood on May 23. Finally, happy Memorial Day on Monday, May 25. Mass on Memorial Day will be at 9:00 a.m.

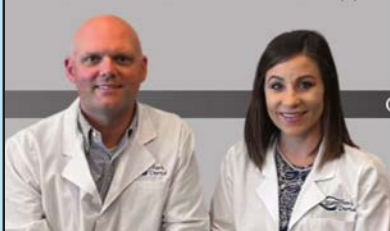

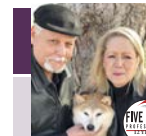
