MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we begin the “in pew” phase of the 2026 Annual Appeal. The Annual Diocesan Appeal is the most important fund raising event of the year for St. Andrew Parish because it is through the Appeal that we support the efforts of the diocese of Columbus and our Bishop in the works of evangelization, Catholic education, vocations to the priesthood, parish support, and pastoral programs throughout the diocese.

The theme for this year’s appeal is “Rooted in Christ, Growing in Mission.” The Appeal goal for this year is \$8.25 million, and St. Andrew Parish is asked to contribute \$229,705.14. That is our share in the overall goal, and it is slightly higher than last year’s goal, which we not only met, but exceeded during the 2025 Appeal.

You have heard me say that it is of great importance that we meet our goal for the Appeal, because if we fall short, the remainder will be added to our diocesan assessment. St. Andrew Parish has always reached and exceeded our Appeal goal, and I am confident that our parishioners will come through again. But I do want to emphasize that the real reason – the best reason – to contribute to the Appeal is to support the vital works of the Diocese of Columbus upon which our parish and our people benefit and depend. Our parish of St. Andrew is “growing in mission” as part of the Diocese of Columbus. We are united as a particular church with our shepherd, Bishop Earl Fernandes, and together we remain “rooted in Christ.” St. Andrew Parish depends upon the Diocese of Columbus, of which we are a part, and the Diocese of Columbus and our bishop depend upon St. Andrew Parish to do our part to support the diocesan mission. That is the reason all of us should generously and cheerfully support the 2026 Annual Appeal. I am counting on you to make a generous pledge or one-time gift to this year’s Appeal. Pledge envelopes are available in the pews, and may be returned in the collection basket, turned in to the parish office, or mailed. Together, let us both meet and exceed our Appeal goal, and help our parish and diocese flourish!

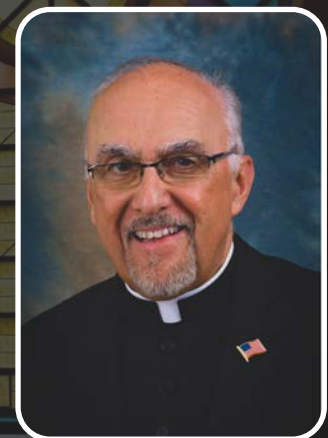

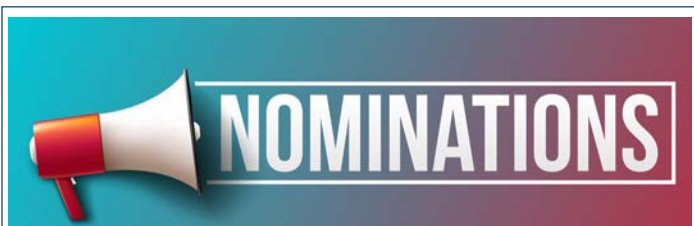
