MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I have a "St. Anthony" story to share with you this week. As you know, St. Anthony is the patron saint of lost articles – he is the saint we pray to when we have lost or misplaced an item, and we ask him to help us find what we have lost.

On the evening of Tuesday, June 9, around 7:30 p.m., I was looking at photos on my cell phone, mainly photos of my dog, Mabel, who sadly was put to sleep on June 6. I was enjoying these memories and was glad that I had taken many pictures of her. The photos on my phone only go back to 2020, so after looking at all of those, I remembered that I had some more photos of Mabel when she was younger on a small digital camera that I used for a brief time back around 2012. I went to find that camera so I could look at those photos, also. I usually keep it in a drawer in the box it came with. I no longer use the camera to take photos, but I keep it so I can view the approximately 150 pictures in the memory. But when I opened the drawer, the box wasn't where it should be. I started looking around my room and after a few minutes, I found the box on a bookshelf. I said "Here it is! I found it!" I opened the box but the camera was not in it. The charger and the instructions booklet were there, but no camera. I was really confused because nobody but me would have removed the camera from the box. So I began searching through my room, looking in every drawer, on every shelf, under every piece of furniture. I knew it had been over a year since I last saw that camera, and I was also sure I never took it out of my room. I spent 45 minutes searching. At 8:30 p.m., I had to go over to the church for Benediction, so I quit my search, but I said a prayer to St. Anthony and asked his help to find my lost camera. During Benediction, I began to think about people who have lost all of their family photos in floods, tornadoes, etc., and that maybe my loss wasn't all that important. I was at peace and I was no longer anxious to find my camera.

The next day, I was moving a chair from a small, unused office in the rectory to the room where our new resident priest will be living. After doing this, I decided to remove some of the other items cluttering that little office into a storage area in the basement of the rectory. I made several trips carrying unused items to the basement and storing them. As I was placing these items in storage, I happened to see a small pet bed on a shelf. It had been given to Melanie when she was a kitten but she never used it so I had put it down in the basement almost two years ago. I picked it up and looked at it, turned it over, and out fell my camera, plopped right in my hand! I knew for certain that St. Anthony found my camera for me!

The following Saturday (June 13) was the feast of St. Anthony, and although I was intending to celebrate the Mass for the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I changed my mind and offered the Mass for St. Anthony of Padua, in thanksgiving for finding my lost camera, and the precious photos! So remember to pray to St. Anthony when you have lost or misplaced something. He will help you find it!
