MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I just returned from my annual vacation last Sunday (July 5) after being gone for about 10 days, so I have some "catching up" to do! As usual, I spent my vacation at my home in Ada, Ohio. The weather was hot most of those days, so I would take a long walk early in the morning each day, and then pretty much stay indoors with the fan and the air-conditioning on. One day, I was driving to Findlay and I passed a country church that had an electronic sign out front with a flashing, changing message. It was about 1:00 p.m. in the afternoon and the temperature was about 93 degrees. As I passed by, I caught part of the message, which said, "There's no AC in Hell." I suppose the message was intended to make one think about the fires of hell and motivate one to repent to avoid them. While it did make me think, my thought was different. Instead, I thought, "I'm glad I didn't get one of those electronic signs for St. Andrew!"

By this time, I am sure you have met our new resident priest, Fr. Barry Eneh. I am very happy to have Fr. Barry with us at St. Andrew and he has already been a great help. We were shorthanded after the departure of Fr. Noble and with Fr. Deville no longer serving as a Mass celebrant, Fr. Barry came at just the right time! I am grateful to Fr. T.J. Lehigh and Fr. Bill Hahn who also celebrated some Masses here at St. Andrew while I was on vacation.

Before we shift into high gear with preparations for our festival, I would like to make another plea for The Appeal 2026. This year, I have been especially encouraging more participation in The Appeal, and I want to thank all who have contributed, especially all of the first-time participants. I believe we can still reach an overall participation rate of 20 percent, but we aren't there yet. And we have not yet reached our goal of \$229,705. So I would like to make one more "push" for pledges and contributions to the diocesan appeal. I do want to remind everyone that if we fail to make our goal, the shortfall will be added to the diocesan assessment bill next year, and nobody wants that to happen. I prefer to emphasize that we should give to the appeal because we should support the work of evangelization in our diocese, especially with vocations, education, and social services, as well as broadening participation. So please make a pledge or gift if you have not done so already, and help us meet all of our goals.

Finally, I am still receiving cards and notes expressing sympathy to me after Mabel's death. I am deeply grateful for everyone's care and concern. I still miss her every day, but it helps knowing she was loved by so many of you! May God bless you all for your kindness.

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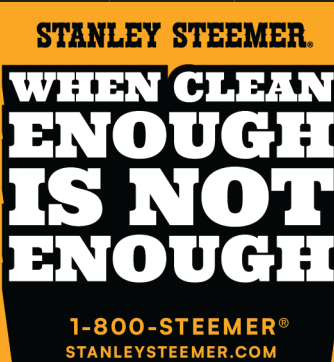


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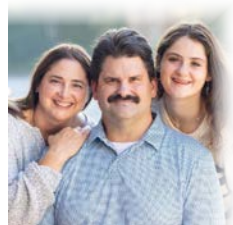
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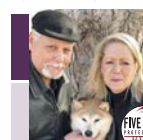


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
