MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

At every Mass, there is a dialogue that takes place at the beginning of the Eucharistic Prayer, just before the Sanctus or "Holy, Holy, Holy." The priest-celebrant says, "The Lord be with you," and everyone responds, "And with your spirit." Then he says, "Lift up your hearts," and everyone responds, "We lift them up to the Lord." Today, I want to reflect on this exhortation to "lift up your hearts."

Whenever I address those words to the congregation at Mass, I think about those whose hearts may be troubled or burdened; those who are worried or depressed; those who are anxious or sad; and those who are "down in the dumps." These are the ones who are especially urged to lift up their hearts. We have every reason to give joyful thanks to the Lord our God. We must lift up our hearts to the Lord, and stop dwelling on our own problems and troubles. I don't want to suggest that those worries and difficulties are trivial or insignificant – but the exhortation to "lift up your hearts" is a reminder that God's love and grace is greater by far than our sadness and fear. We are urged to rise above our disconsolate spirits and lift up our broken hearts to the Lord! I am not suggesting that you should simply "put on a happy face," or "smile though your heart is breaking." To lift up your hearts to the Lord is an act of faith and trust, which brings some peace to those who are troubled in spirit, and lifts the spirits of those who are downcast.

I hope you will truly "lift up your hearts" whenever you hear those words spoken to you at Mass!

May God bless you all during these warm summer days!
