MESSAGE FROM THE DEACON

Dear Parishioners,

Because of our clergy vacations this weekend, I was asked to fill in for Monsignor's column. As I was reflecting on what to write about, I realized that this weekend we celebrate the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. With this document, the United States of America was established. And the guiding ideas are shown in the preamble to this document: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." From the very beginning, this country was founded upon liberties that were given by God the Creator. And it took a war and about 15 years to draft and approve the Constitution and its Bill of Rights, but it is very clear that these liberties are seen to be given to us by God.

The Catholic Church also teaches that liberty is a gift from God and a fundamental human right, inseparable from the dignity of the person. *Gaudium et Spes*, one of the four main documents of the Second Vatican Council, along with many other teachings, affirm that religious liberty is a human right and a prerequisite for other freedoms. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops emphasizes that religious freedom allows the Church and all communities to live out their faith in public and serve the common good.

So this weekend, let us celebrate that we live in a country that sees liberty as a divine gift that is to be protected. Let us be proud to commit to religious freedom by showing our Catholic faith to others so that they can see God's love.

Hoping you have had a great 4th of July celebration.

The T-coil hearing loop system reduces most background noise and improves understanding of speech and music. **If you would like to take advantage of the T-coil function in the church**, you will need to ask your Hearing Care Provider (HCP) to add it to your device. After this, simply press the button on the back of your hearing aid and select the program that your HCP has assigned to T-coil.

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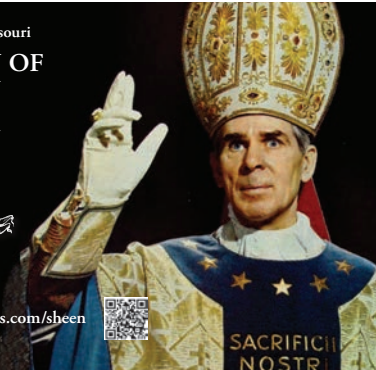

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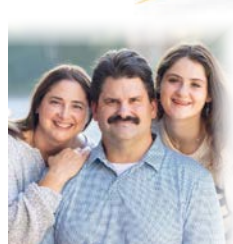
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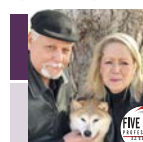
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
