MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This week, we begin the month of September, as Tuesday is the first of the month. Before I comment on things to look for in the coming month, I want to give a brief recap of the month of August, because August was a wild and crazy month here at St. Andrew Parish. For starters, Fr. Lawrence Tabi's journey to his homeland was unexpectedly prolonged. He was due back on August 6, but was forced to delay his return until August 28. I am happy to have him back after such a long absence.

On August 11, a terrible storm caused major damage and power outages all around Ohio, including our Upper Arlington neighborhood and St. Andrew Parish. We carried on bravely, and we had a safe and successful Festival on August 14 and 15, giving our parishioners and community at large an opportunity to escape from their troubles for a time. At about 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, heavy rain returned, sending crowds home a little before closing time. August 19 was the first day of school at St. Andrew School. Enrollment is 470 students this year!

And don't forget that this weekend (August 29 and 30) there is a second collection for the Spirit of Hope Fund. This supports the diocesan Disaster Response team as they assist those who have lost so much as a result of flooding and storm damage right here in the Diocese of Columbus, in particular, Perry and Muskingum Counties. Also this weekend, St. Vincent de Paul is holding the annual Fall Donation Drive. There is a truck in the McCoy Road parking lot where you can drop off donations (see the information on this page for more details).

Looking ahead to September, I will mention only a couple of things. Monday, Sept. 7, is Labor Day and there will be one Mass only at 9:00 a.m. The weekend of September 12 and 13, Fr. Steven Borello will be here and speak at all Masses on behalf of the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS) and the FOCUS missionaries who evangelize on college campuses.

That's all for now. May God bring your August to a happy conclusion and bless you with a happier September!

MUSIC MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES



Seasonal rehearsals of our parish music ensembles begin soon, and new members are invited to join our ministry community! Do you have talents to share, or musical interests and abilities yet to be explored? Are you looking to reawaken your skills from music lessons long ago? Can you make a short eight-

week commitment to participate in one of our parish choirs? Here are some options to consider:

THE ST. ANDREW CHOIR provides music for the 9:15 a.m. Sunday Masses (September-June) in addition to other Holy Days, holidays, and special occasions. The group is open to men and women of high school age and beyond, and rehearsals are typically held on Thursday evenings at 7:00 p.m. While music reading ability is helpful, it is not required to become a choir member. You must simply be able to match pitch, blend your voice with others, be available for rehearsals as well as liturgies, and have a desire to help others pray and praise God through music. The choir season consists of four "quarters," and singers may sign up for any (or all) of the sessions as they are available throughout the year. Singers get an extended winter and summer break. Rehearsals begin in mid-September.

THE RESURRECTION (FUNERAL) CHOIR serves the parish by singing for our parish funerals throughout the year. This choir is an excellent option for those who enjoy singing and have some flexibility with their daytime (especially morning) schedules but are unable to commit to the Sunday choir. New members (both men and women) are always welcome. This choir is a meaningful way to honor our parishioners who have died, and to provide consolation to their loved ones in their time of loss.

THE ST. ANDREW HANDBELL CHOIR is the newest addition to our parish music ministry program. A basic knowledge of music reading is helpful for this group, but no previous ringing experience is necessary, and no singing is required! The Handbell Choir typically rehearses seasonally on Wednesday evenings at 7:00 p.m. with an extended winter and summer break. Introductory and tutoring sessions are offered, as needed, for those who would like to learn the basics of ringing. Now is the time to start!

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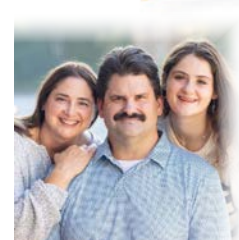
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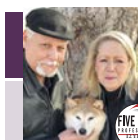
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
