MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Last Sunday, in my homily, I spoke about "acts of God," which is a legal term used when describing property damage caused by natural forces, such as wind, earthquake, or fire, rather than by human activity. I was making the point that while we may call natural disasters "acts of God," it doesn't mean that God is intentionally inflicting the damage as a form of punishment or vengeance. I pointed out that the prophet Ezekiel, while waiting for God to pass by, witnessed the crushing wind, an earthquake, and a fire, but God was not in any of them. Rather, He was in the "tiny whispering sound" that made Ezekiel hide his face in reverence.

On this past Tuesday, we were struck by a destructive storm that your homeowner's insurance policy would categorize as an "act of God." Perhaps your home or automobile was damaged by the wind and heavy rain or by falling trees and downed power lines. Many areas of Upper Arlington saw trees split and fallen, blocking the streets and knocking out power. Here at St. Andrew, the row of Sycamore trees along Reed Road were heavily damaged and about half of them will be lost.

We also had a window blown out in one of the school classrooms. Power in the church and school was not interrupted, but the rectory and parish office was affected by a power outage. Thankfully, our emergency generator kept the lights on, but we had no phone service or internet access.

As I write this message (on Wednesday, Aug. 12), it is unclear how this will affect our festival. We are planning to proceed with it and hopeful we can be ready by Friday.

Speaking of hope, we must listen to the tiny whispering voice of God telling us to hope in Him even in the midst of the hardships we are currently experiencing.

May God bless you all and give you strength and courage to persevere through these difficult days. As I told the early morning Mass crowd this morning, "Have a good day—if possible."

If you would like to take advantage of the T-coil function in the church, you will need to ask your Hearing Care Provider (HCP) to add it to your device. After this, simply press the button on the back of your hearing aid and select the program that your HCP has assigned to T-coil.

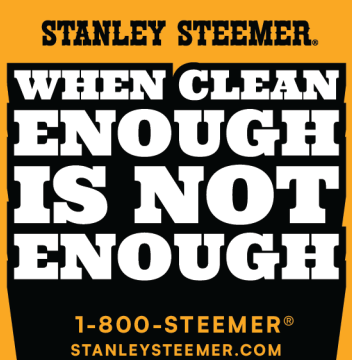

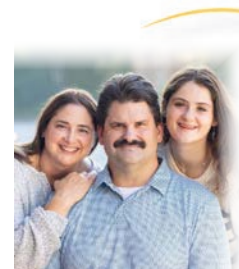

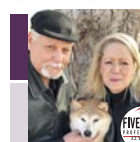
