Dear Parishioners,

Happy August! We begin the month of August this weekend, and that means we are approaching the end of summer. After this, simply press the button on the back of your hearing aid and select the program that your HCP has assigned to T-coil.

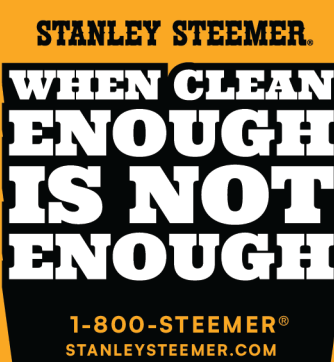

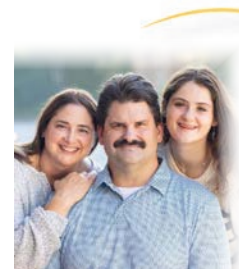

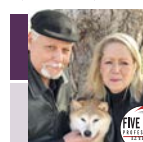
