## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This past couple of weeks have been eventful and challenging! Last weekend, we held The Festival at St. Andrew, which in spite of the challenges, was very successful. As you know, the destructive storm that passed through our area on August 11 caused a lot of damage in our neighborhood and interrupted the power supply for several days. I am very grateful to our festival committee members and all the volunteers who worked really hard and helped us be ready to open the festival on Friday afternoon. Some of those workers had damage and power issues at their own homes, and yet they focused their efforts on helping St. Andrew festival succeed. The power came back on around 3:30 p.m. Friday, not long before the festival opened. This was an answer to our prayers, but our ingenious festival committee already had a backup plan to supply electricity if it became necessary. It was rewarding to see the large crowd of people, young and old, having a good time at the festival! I am sure that many had been without power for several days, and were eager to get out of their dark houses, eat some good food, and enjoy the sights and sounds.

Here at St. Andrew we lost several trees completely, and a few other trees had major damage. Overall though, we were very lucky. I know many of our neighbors and some of our parishioners were not so lucky. This series of storms caused disastrous damage locally and in surrounding counties and states. Right here in our Diocese of Columbus, major flooding in Perry and Muskingum Counties has been truly devastating and has received national media attention. You may recall that last year, the Diocese of Columbus established a Disaster Response Team and a response manual to enable us to be ready to respond to disasters affecting our local communities. A fund was also established called "The Spirit of Hope Fund," to collect donations and disperse assistance to help communities in need. In the present circumstances, there is a great need to help support disaster response in Perry and Muskingum counties, so Bishop Fernandes has ordered the release of funds from the Spirit of Hope Fund for this purpose, and has also ordered that a special second collection be taken up in all parishes of the Diocese on the last weekend in August to replenish this fund so that even more support to the relief efforts may be given in the present and in the future. We will be taking up this special collection at Masses on Saturday, Aug. 29, and Sunday, Aug. 30. I ask you to please be generous.
