Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we have an opportunity to learn about and support missionary outreach on college campuses. Rev. Steven Borello will speak at all Masses about the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS) and their missionaries who evangelize to college students.

This is but one aspect of evangelization, and it is a reminder that we are a missionary church. The task given to the whole Church by our Lord is this: Go and make disciples of all the nations! 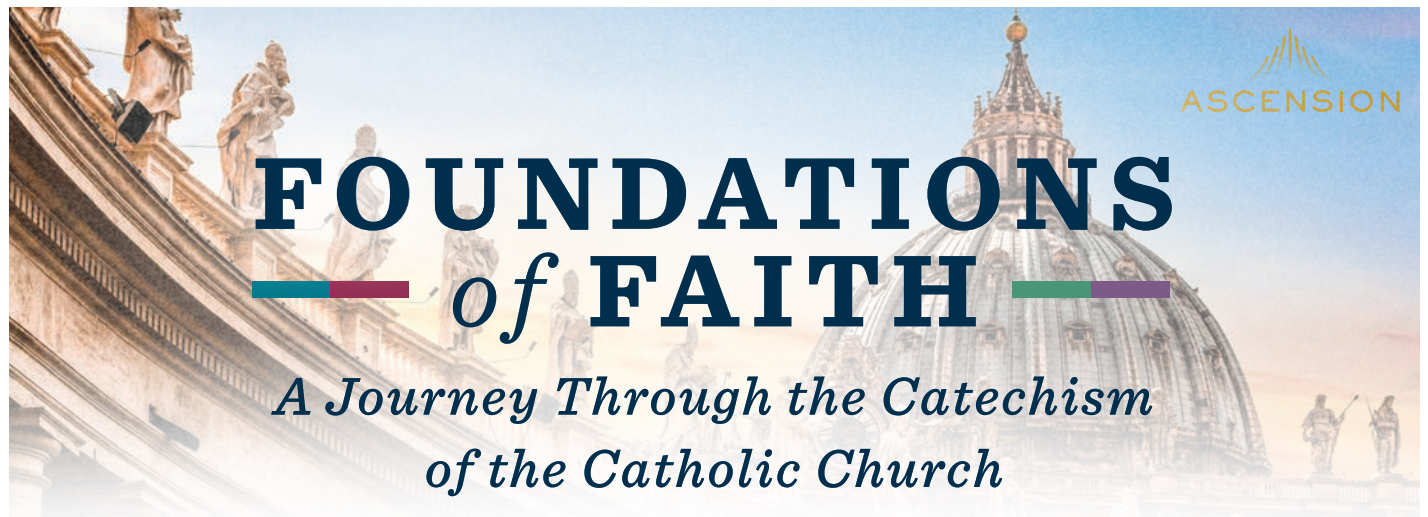

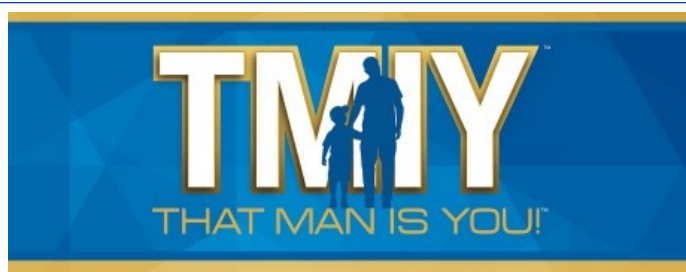

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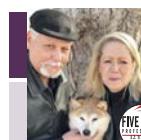
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
