MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Think for a moment how often you hear these words spoken: "God bless you!" Or the words spoken by the priest at the end of Mass: "May almighty God bless you, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit."

We frequently say words of blessing or hear the words of a blessing spoken to us. We may say, "God bless you" when someone sneezes. We may ask a priest for a special blessing for a birthday, wedding anniversary, when traveling, or other occasions. We may ask for a blessing upon religious articles like rosaries, medals, or statues. The Latin word for "blessing" is "benedictio," which literally means "to speak well." Blessings play a prominent role in our Catholic tradition. The Church provides a "Book of Blessings," which contains prayers and short rituals of blessing for every occasion and for blessing of all kinds of human activities and creations. There are even blessings for homes and automobiles.

It has become very common for children and others who are not receiving Holy Communion at Mass to come forward in the Communion procession and ask for and receive a blessing. A blessing is not just an empty gesture or meaningless words. A blessing invokes God's name and imparts God's presence and power upon the person being blessed. Blessings are primarily bestowed on people, and even when things are blessed for some purpose, the blessing really extends to those who will use the object.

A blessing is something very meaningful, very powerful, and very important. A blessing should never be taken lightly or regarded dismissively.

May you always be aware of how richly you have been blessed by God! As the saying goes, "Count your blessings." And here is one more: May almighty God bless you this day!

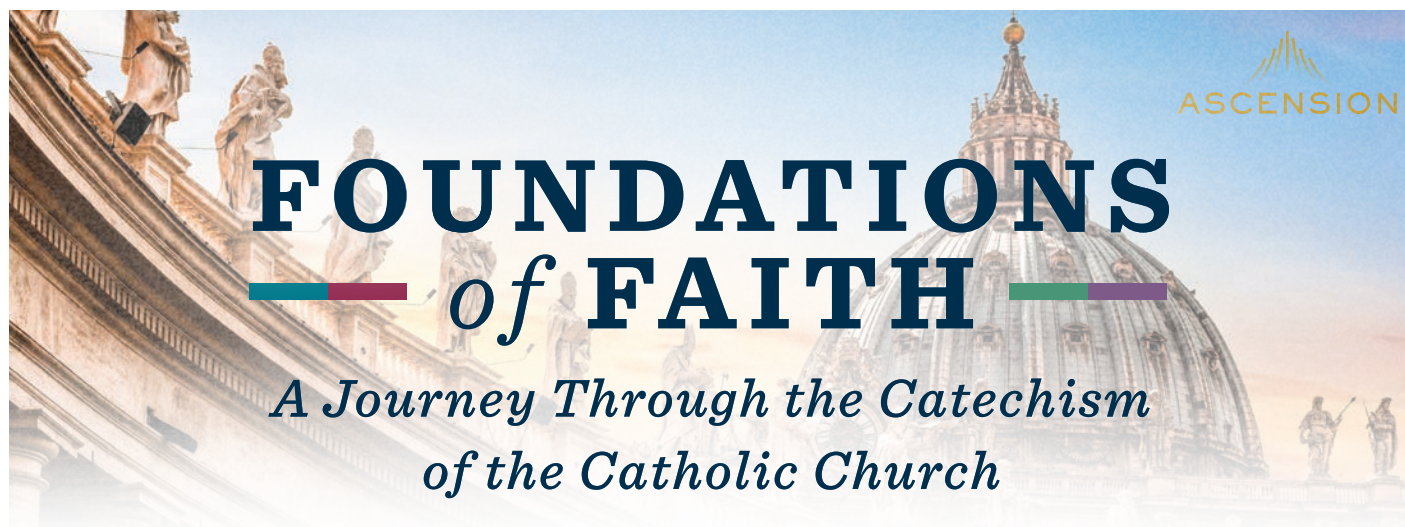

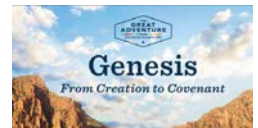
TUESDAY EVENING BIBLE STUDY
