MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

As I write these words, it is Tuesday, Sept. 1, which happens to be the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, established by Pope Francis on August 6, 2015. It is observed annually on September 1, and is intended to "offer believers and communities a fitting opportunity to reaffirm their personal vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork that He has entrusted to our care, and to implore His help for the protection of creation as well as His pardon for the sins committed against the world in which we live." The period from September 1 through October 4 (the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi) is designated as the "Season of Creation," a time of prayer and action focused on caring for the environment, reducing waste, and conserving natural resources.

I was a little late to get this message, as I saw it in the "Ordo" as I was preparing for Mass early this morning. But it occurred to me that the theme of the Care of Creation is very fitting for Labor Day. In fact, I often celebrate the votive Mass for the Blessing of Human Labor on Labor Day. It echoes the theme that God created the world and everything in it, and entrusted the care of the whole world to human beings. In our work, we share in God's work of creation, and we share God's power as we exercise dominion over all creatures. God has entrusted this work to us and has assigned us the task of being stewards of creation. Thus, it is very fitting that we ask God's blessing upon this work as we gather to celebrate Mass on Labor Day.

Labor Day falls on Monday, Sept. 7, and Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 a.m. that day.

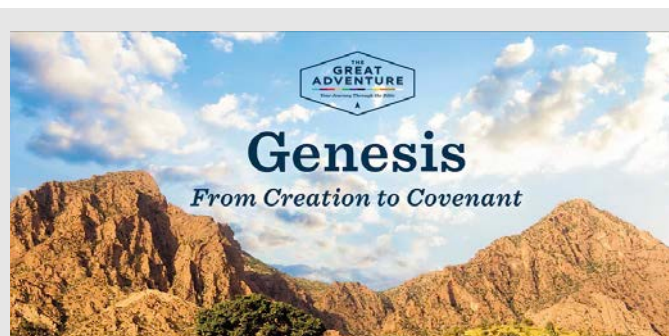

ST. ANDREW PARISH CHOIR rehearses on Thursday evenings and sings for the 9:15 a.m. Mass on Sundays in addition to other holy days and special occasions

from September through June. There are currently openings for all voice parts. The choir season consists of four "quarters," and singers may sign up for any (or all) of the sessions as they are available throughout the year. 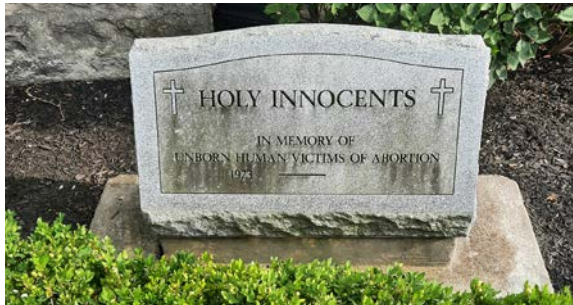

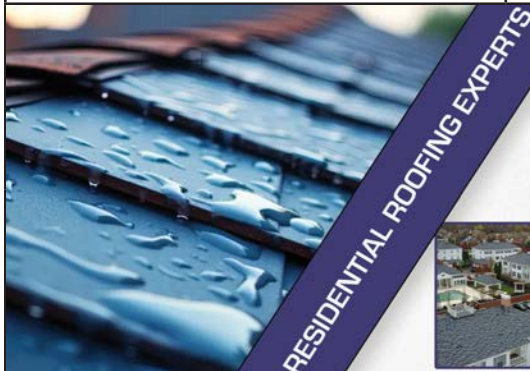

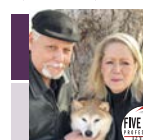
